Minutes of the July 6th, 2026 Board Meeting

Meeting called to order at 6:00 PM.

Old Business

- June treasurers report and minutes of the of the June meeting approved unanimously.
- We were informed that Homer took Mark's request for a quote as an order and subsequently the full truck order has been delivered to us including 7 pallets of Orange Top, 15 pallets of Orange Dome and 1 pallet each of Rabbit and Black. Invoice was for \$26034.81 including \$2850 for freight.
- We then got into a very long and often heated discussion on raising the prices for clay targets. Several alternatives were presented and discussed and various points of view were presented. In the end, a vote to approve a motion to raise the costs to \$9 per 25 for non-members at sporting clays, \$8 for non-members at T/S, \$8 for members at sporting clays and \$7 for members at T/S was approved. In addition, the Daily member fee shall be increased to \$12 and the members Guest fee shall be \$6. These changes go into effect August 1st. Additional increases for outside groups and law enforcement will be discussed in the future.
- The discussion on a camping policy was tabled for a future date.

New Business

- Director Dennis indicated that the June Registered Trap event was poorly attended and there are not many signed up for the July Trap event.
- Jared said SC doing fine, good comments on the new layout. Jared and Dennis felt that they were prepared for a large turnout for the Western Zone Trap event. Gene provided \$250 for lunches for that event and he wanted it noted that he donated two picnic tables to the range. The tables have been cleaned up and repaired.
- Thanks to efforts by Mark, we've started to receive sponsorship donations for the sporting clays positions and Jared said he'd work on a procedure to be approved by the Board.
- Jim said concrete work for ADA ramp was completed but he needs to address some drainage issues.
- We did not have the discussion of monthly operating expenses or actual expenses as that was covered earlier in the meeting.
