Minutes of the February 16th, 2026 Board Meeting

Meeting called to order at 6:03 PM.

Non-Agenda Items

- Bill Tocci talked about Zeffy, a software app that assists in handling credit card payments and membership. Tom indicated he would look into it. Bill also mentioned that our website had some areas that we might want to update.
- Mark and Warren gave an update on the Polaris repairs and Tom issued them checks for the repairs. Everyone thanked them for all their work. We agreed to remove the broken windshield and not replace it at this time.
- Mark asked about the use of a new dumpster company he knew of and he'll verify pricing after we determined we will need two dumpsters and we're ok with one pick up per month.

Old Business

- January treasurers report and minutes of the of the January meeting approved unanimously.

New Business

- Jared indicated that Dennis will now be the Director in charge of T/S and Jared will assist with any T/S communications. Director Dennis indicated he's serviced both skeet throwers and he'll schedule repairs to our generator and the 5 trap machines. Bill and Mark said they'd assist if Dennis lets them know the schedule. Jared said we have quite a bit of work to do on the SC course, finishing the new route and testing the machines. He said Kim Nichols will organize a youth landscaping effort early this season.
- After discussion, it was agreed to run the Western Zone and a Registered SC event on the same weekend in July. Jared indicated that he would like to have 10-12 volunteers available to assist with the 3 day Zone event. Gene indicated he would handle any needs for the SC event.
- We discussed the need to have better guidelines regarding alcohol on the range and we tabled further discussion while Tom develops suggested language and we can finalize at the March meeting.
- We discussed and agreed to recognize the many years of Steve Long's commitment to the range by naming the T/S area the Steve Long Memorial Trap Range and erecting a sign by the entrance to that venue.
- We briefly discussed our rate structure and agreed to table the decision until March after Tom presents a comparison matrix for all G&F ranges showing all fees other locations charge
