Minutes of the August 15th, 2022 Telephonic Board Meeting

Attendees: Ron Talbott, President, Tom Mackin Secretary, Deb Wolf, Director, Jared Wesley Director and Steve Long, Director, Lou Arminio Treasurer,

Meeting called to order at 6:34 PM.

Ron asked about other items to discuss not on the agenda and with a very brief discussion of a phone call from Chere McCracken regarding Registered Trap shoots,, meeting proceeded.

Tom presented the Treasurer's report, balance at June month end of \$23,682.65. There was a motion to approve the financial report by Steve, second by Ron, approved by all. Tom asked to approve the minutes of our July meeting, motion by Steve, second by Jared, approved by all.

Moving on the Director reports, Steve said he had received some repaired or replacement "pickles" for the Voice System for trap and most trap fields were now repaired and operating correctly. Jared indicated there was some damage to some card readers from monsoon rains but he was working on repairs and possible replacements form another range.He also mentioned that due to the heavy rains in the forecast for the weekend, Canyon Clays has cancelled the Registered SC shoot for August and will present their final shoot September 16-18. Ron indicated that the 100 yard range was getting covered each week with 2 RSO's and staying moderately busy. Deb has been working with Tom on new agreements for NAUPD and the NAURanger program. Tom mentioned that CCC is looking into an agreement for training at NASR.

We then discussed the return to our regular hours, 9-3 starting in September and Steve and Jared were ok with that and Tom will ask Steve Ruff if the 100 yard RSO's can deal with that. Shooters will still need to arrive at least one hour before closing.

Next teleconference meeting was scheduled for 6:30 PM on September 12th. At 7:13, Tom made a motion to adjourn, Steve seconded, all were in favor.
