Minutes of the March 16th, 2026 Board Meeting

Attendees: Tom Mackin Secretary, Ron Talbott, President, Gene Warner Vice President via Phone, Directors Jim Timney, Jared Wesley and Dennis Loescher,
Meeting called to order at 6:15 PM.

Non-Agenda Items

- Ron indicated that he took several hundred pounds of brass to Phoenix and sold it for \$1757.50, a good return.
- Ron then suggested we donate one of our .22 Cricket rifles to the April 18th Friends of NRA Banquet. He also suggested we purchase 8 tickets to the dinner to recognize 8 of our regular volunteers. Both measures passed unanimously.
- Jared mentioned that Kim Nicholls requested 4 dates for 4H shooters. Jared said he'd ask her for a Range Request form.

Old Business

- February treasurers report and minutes of the of the February meeting approved unanimously.

New Business

- Director Dennis indicated he's serviced our large generator and still has some maintenance on the trap machines. Dennis will also like to get our old generator functioning for a back up, Jared mentioned that the card reader at trap 3 was not functioning properly so they switched it with Trap 2.
- Jared said we need to order some additional cards from Golden West. He also said the propane tank at SC is now plumbed but additional work is needed to provide power to two of the conex's and the office. He's scheduled a work day for March 28 to set up the sc course,
- After discussion, Gene let us know that he's rescheduled the July SC shoot for the last weekend of July instead of concurrent with the Western Zone. Jared will contact Cherele and discuss her availability for the ZONE and the several monthly ATA shoots. Jared also indicated the Mark and Warren will handle the food prep for the ZONE.
- We discussed request from Meagan at HQ to have a SCTP shoot on May 23rd, with Canyon Clays handling the arrangements, including fees and waivers. Gene will secure a Range Request form.
- We agreed that our alcohol policy is never any on any ranges and consumption is allowed only after shooting hours for campers and others. Tom will update forms and work on signs.
- We discussed our rate structure and agreed to increase memberships by \$10 each, leave Daily as is, and only charge junior guests \$5. We will also leave the cost for clays as is. Membership changes will be effective May 1st.
- Plans to open then clay venues on Saturday April 4th
