Minutes of the April 18th, 2022 Telephonic Board Meeting

Attendees: Ron Talbott, President, Tom Mackin Secretary, Lou Arminio Treasurer, Deb Wolf, Director, Jared Wesley Director and Steve Long, Director
Meeting called to order at 6:36PM.

Ron asked about other items to discuss not on the agenda and Deb mentioned that she'd been contact by a gentleman affiliated with the Civil Air Patrol cadet program and he was interested in conducting a class on weapons handling and marksmanship for the cadets. Ron mentioned he was an NRA instructor and Deb said she'd forward Ron this gentleman's contact info.

Tom presented the Treasurer's report, balance at March month end of \$38,427.25. There was a motion to approve the financial report by Steve, second by Jared, approved by all Ron asked to approve the minutes of our March meeting, motion by Tom, second by Steve, approved by all.

We discussed the desire to have the range open on additional days and Tom indicated that he had sent out an email to all members asking for assistance with RSO duties and both the 100 yard range and the clay target venues. Ron received one inquiry to assist at SC, he sent that info to Jared, Jared reached out to the individual and never heard back. A few folks who've been to the range lately expressed some interest in RSO duty at the 100 yard range but they've never pursued it any further. There was also no interest in manning a Greeter area or in donating or selling a UTV to the range. It appears that at this time, range days will not be expanded.

We then discussed a replacement vehicle for the clay target area and the Board approved a tentative budget of up to \$12K for an expenditure. Jared is to look into finding a suitable vehicle and report back to the Board. Steve indicated that he's been in touch with Chere McCracken and the June Registered shoot is all set to go. Jared indicated the same thing for the Canyon Clays SC shoot also scheduled for June. We then discussed the order for the clays and Jared is to contact Walmart and arrange to purchase up to 8 pallets. Jim Timney has volunteered to assist with transporting the targets to the range.

Steve asked Jared to ship the card reader from Field 5 out for repair along with three that Jared has from SC and Jared said he'd do that. Jared has ordered batteries and will soon be replacing some of the extension cords, everything else is fine. Steve said John Winnicki replaced a spring in trap 5 and it now functions properly. Maintenance has been done on both generators. Jared will hold off on any additional work on the new SC course layout due to a lack of material for the new access road. Deb indicated that LE has been using the range a great deal, almost every day and has scheduled similar usage at least through May.

Next teleconference meeting was scheduled for 6:30 PM on May 16th. Ron will be in Canada for May so Tom will lead the meeting. Steve made a motion to adjourn at 8:03, second by Deb and all agreed.
