Daily fees: ASTA - \$3.00: ATA - \$4.00

1. Daily fees of \$4.00 ATA and \$3.00 ASTA will be collected **once per day per participant**. A \$1.50 WZ fee will be collected for **each 100 targets**.
2. This shoot has been authorized by the ATA and will be conducted in accordance with ATA and Zone-specific rules. The Arizona ATA Delegate will be in charge of classification and will ensure targets are set per ATA Rules. Please be sure to have your **AVERAGE CARD** up to date for proper classification.
3. Arizona residents must be current ASTA members.
4. There are no target requirements or Class advancements for this shoot.
5. Classification, squadding and cashiering will open at **2:00 pm on Wednesday, July 15, 2026** and **7:00 am** daily thereafter. Practice trap is available each day beginning at **7:30 am**.
6. **PLEASE NOTE: For Club Trophies, AAA, AA, and A will be combined into one Class**. Shooters will still be classified per the table below for Zone wide purposes.
7. Special Category shooters (as defined by ATA rules) **must** make their declaration when they are classified. That designation cannot be changed for the duration of the tournament. Rule Section X, D.5
8. White Flyer targets will be thrown. Picking up empty shells from the ground during or after shooting is not permitted.
9. Advance squadding will be available using SOS Clays pre-squad utility.

SOLICITING

No soliciting, selling of chances, or similar activities will be allowed on the grounds, nor shall any literature of any kind be distributed on the grounds without written approval by the ATA and NASR.

SALES AND DISTRIBUTION

No Soliciting, selling or distribution of shot shells or any types of goods or wares are allowed on the club premises without express written permission of the NASR. Violators will be removed from the premises.

RV CAMPING and HOTELS

Free dry camping is allowed onsite at NASR. There are several Hotels and Motels in Flagstaff, AZ.

By the act of classifying and participating, each shooter has indicated they assume and accept full responsibility for themselves and their minor children, for bodily injury, death, or loss of personal property and expenses as a result of inherent risks and dangers.

This Program will govern the Tournament; the Amateur Trapshooting Association rules will govern all points not otherwise provided for. Management reserves the absolute right, in its sole discretion, at any time prior to or during this Tournament to change or modify the program in any manner it desires. The management reserves the right to refuse any entry or disqualify anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of this shoot in any manner.

TROPHIES AND ADDED MONEY

Trophies and Added Monies have been contributed by:

Added money of \$10,000 (\$3,000 from the ATA and \$7,000 from the Western Zone) will be paid out on the 1,000 HOA targets (Events 1 – 9) via the Lewis Class five classes, 60/40% per class. No entry fee required. All shooters who shoot the HOA are eligible. Payout of the HOA Lewis will be by Zone Shoot Administrator (SOS Clays).

The ASTA has contributed the Club trophies for this tournament.

The ATA and the Western Zone provide Zone Wide Trophies. ATA and Western Zone Wide trophies will be shipped to the winners by the trophy vendors. Please make sure your correct address is on file with the ATA.

In addition to the silver award, ASTA will give out a \$100 check to the HAA and HOA Champions.

ATA TROPHIES

The following rules apply to every event which includes ATA trophies and/or All-American points on any event:

1. Only one (1) trophy shall be awarded to any one (1) person in any separate event. This means a contestant may not win both special category trophy and champion, runner-up/place, class, or yardage trophy in the same event. Shooter must complete the event to be eligible for ATA trophies and All-American points.
2. A chair shooter whose score qualifies them for more than one (1) ATA trophy must notify shoot management as to which trophy he/ she desires to accept or shoot for. The shooter must make his/her declaration after the scores for each EVENT are posted and before entering in to any shoot-off/carry-over. The maximum time allowed for such declaration shall be made by shoot management, within a range of 15 minutes. This declaration should be made at a place specified by shoot management. If the shooter fails to make a declaration within the specified time, shoot management shall assign "Chair" as the choice.
3. Any shooter who is tied for event Champion may shoot-off/carry-over for the Championship trophy. If a shooter fails in the championship trophy shoot-off/carry-over and has declared a special category at the time of classification, the shooter will fall back to the declared special category.
4. Any shooter who has declared a special category at the time of classification and whose score qualifies for any trophy in his/her declared category, will compete for the category trophy and not for place, class or yardage group. If there is no Event Champion Trophy, a declared Category shooter will take the Category Trophy and may not fall back to the Class Trophy.
5. Any special category shooter whose score does not qualify for a trophy in his/her category, may compete for place, class or yardage group trophies.
6. Once started, any event must be completed within 24 hours of the last event of the tournament. If any event is not completed, all unused target and option money must be refunded to the shooters who do not complete the event.
7. When a state or provincial championship is held concurrently with an ATA Zone tournament, the state/provincial championship shall be required to conform to the same classification system, minimum target requirements and assigned penalty class/yardage as specified for the ATA Zone tournament.

SHOOT REPORTING AND RESULTS

Event scores for all clubs will be uploaded directly to the Western Zone website shootatazone.com at the conclusion of each event. Zone Wide scores can be viewed, and you will be able to determine high scores in Class,

Category, Handicap or State after each event. Shoot management will also post data from the website in the clubhouse. If you have Internet access or a web enabled phone, you will be able to check all scores after each event at the Zone Wide Leader Board.

SHOOT-OFFS AND TARGET BANKING

Thursday

Class winners will not be advanced for succeeding events. NASR Singles and Doubles Ties will be carried over to the respective Friday Events. For the Steve Long Memorial Handicap (Event 2) any shooter in contention for Zone Wide trophy will begin banking 25 target sub-events following NASR Doubles Championship (Event 3).

Friday

Class winners will not be advanced for succeeding events. Class Singles and Doubles Ties will be carried over to the respective Championship Events. For the Preliminary Handicap (Event 5) any shooter in contention for Zone Wide trophy will begin banking 25 target sub-events following Class Singles Championship (Event 6).

Saturday

Shooters with 200 straight will begin banking targets promptly at the conclusion of the event in 25 target sub-events.

Special Category and Class shooters should remain on the grounds until they know if they are involved in a shoot-off or in contention for a Zone Wide trophy.

Sunday

Shooters with 100 straight in Doubles or Handicap will start banking targets as soon as possible. Doubles will be shot off in ten (10) pair sub-events. Handicap will be shot off in (25) target sub-events. Ties for Club Trophies will be shot off at this time also.

Do not leave the grounds until you are sure of your Zone Wide status.

HOA AND HAA

HOA shoot-offs will consist of 20 Singles, 10 Handicap and 5 Pair of Doubles targets, repeated if necessary. HAA shoot-offs will consist of 20 Singles, 10 Handicap and 5 Pair of Doubles, repeated if necessary.

PURSES AND OPTIONS

Purses and Options are not compulsory. No changes or withdrawals will be allowed after the event has started. No part of Option money is held out. Payoff sheets for Events 1 – 7 will be posted and the payoff sheet for Events 8 & 9 will be mailed. It will be the responsibility of all Purse and Option Winners to report their winnings to the IRS. Checks not cashiered within ninety (90) days will become void.

SCORES

Scores are final for Purse and Option calculation one (1) hour after event is completed. Subsequent to this deadline, scores will be corrected for ATA record purposes only.

ATA 100 AND 200 STRAIGHT PINS

Shooters breaking one hundred (100) or two hundred (200) straight without carryover will be eligible for an ATA 100 or 200 straight pin. Only one such pin will be awarded to any individual. Please inquire at the Office. This is a one-time award and previous winners are not eligible.

SHELLS

The club will have a limited selection of loads for sale by the box or case. Rental of venter space does not constitute authority to sell shells on the grounds.
